The recent Work Party built a new target berm at 50 yards on the rifle range. In addition, there is now a spinner bunker for RIMFIRE ONLY on the rifle range. Bring your own spinners.

Rifle Range Rules: The new 50-yard rifle backstop and spinner bunker have been installed. We are still working out some of the rules, but here's a start:

50-yard spinner bunker: 1. Rimfire only! 2. Spinners and self-healing targets only. 3. Cans, bottles, other objects are prohibited.

50-yard backstop: 1. Paper targets only. 2. Targets MUST be placed so your shot will impact the dirt backstop. 3. 24" *18" political sign frames work very well. Bring some along if you have them. There is cardboard available in the pistol house if you need a backer. 4. Center-fire is allowed on the 50 yard backstop.

100-yard steel bunker: 1. Bring your own steel target. 2. Your target MUST be designed for the load you are shooting. 3. Cans, bottles, other objects are prohibited.

If you have suggestions for additional rules, please notify a Board Member or bring it up at the next meeting.
