



2022 Bullseye Pistol 1800 Matches

Lancaster Pistol and Rifle club will be hosting Three Gun 1800 Bullseye matches on the first Saturday of the month (excluding July). Match will have 12 firing points with static targets at 50 yards and turning targets at 25 yards. A maximum of 2 relays if attendance requires. Every effort will be made to complete the match, parking is available adjacent to the firing line. Beverages will be available.

Time: Range will be open for registration at 8:00AM with first shots being no earlier than 9:00AM

Location: 3980 Brook Road, Lancaster, OH 43130

Match Fees: Match fee is \$30. Preregistration by email is preferred.

Rules and Scoring: The 25th Edition of the CMP Pistol rules will be used for this Match and will be available at the range. NOTE: the course of fire is modified and scores will NOT be reported. Competitors will be responsible for scoring (pass score card to the right, score to the left) and posting targets. If a competitor needs assistance it must be made known to the match director in order for accommodations to be made. Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) are mandatory. Competitors may challenge a Target for a \$1 challenge fee. A match official will oversee the challenge. Score cards must be signed by both scorer and competitor before turning in. Match director may compete for no awards.

Classification: Competitors will follow CMP classification rules. Unclassified shooters will shoot in the Master Class. Four competitors per classification are required for class awards. Classes will be combined if necessary. The winner of each match will be subtracted from that class before computing award.

Course of Fire: Course of fire is modified from the CMP 25th edition rule book. Course of fire will be a 3x600, a 600 aggregate course of fire for each 22, Centerfire and 45 caliber. Competitors may elect to shoot 22 only.

Equipment: ECIs, hearing and eye protection are mandatory. Staplers will be needed for posting and repairing targets. It is recommended the competitors have spotting scopes if desired.

Awards: Class awards will be determined by award schedule. Competitors will automatically be entered into a raffle to be drawn at the end of the season, each competitor gets one entry per match attended.

600 Aggregate Course of Fire

- Two 10 shot strings Slow fire in 10 minutes at 50 yards on a B6 target. One string of fire per target.
- Four 5 shot strings of Timed Fire, 20 seconds per string at 25 yards on a B8 target. Two strings of fire per target
- Four 5 shot strings of Rapid Fire, 10 seconds per string at 25 yards on a B8 target. Two strings of fire per target
