LPRC.22 RIMFIRE RIFLE LEAGUE 2024

This is for fun and competition against yourself and other shooters.

This not sanctioned by any group, just internal to the club.

One scored league "season" is scheduled for 2024. We will be starting in March and plan to wrap up around mid-June. If you want to get started on the league a little early, that's perfectly fine, the goal is to promote participation. Match fee will be \$5.00 (\$10.00 if you shoot in both rifle divisions), "official" match time is Tuesday evenings, but you may shoot any time the range is open and available.

TARGETS/RIFLES/SCOPES/RESTS/AMMUNITION: We will be using IBS Rimfire 50 yard, targets. There are 25 scoring rings with the possibility of 10 points for each ring for a total possible score of 250 per target. Any .22 caliber rimfire rifle is fine, even target rifles provided that they do not utilize any type of barrel tuner. Rifle scopes with no more than 18 power may be used. Any .22 rimfire ammo is permitted. If you upgrade your rifle to a more accurate one you may use the new rifle to complete your scores. You may use a basic type front rest and a separate rear sand bag type rest. No one piece front and rear rests or clamp style rests for the rifle.

All targets for the league will be handed out at the same time to a competitor. You will receive 10 targets, the 10 competition targets will be marked as competition targets and numbered 1-10 and will be the only targets that count toward your score. You must have another club member score your targets. All targets, scored or un-scored, should be placed in the rifle house for collection. If your target needs scoring, it may be placed in the rifle house in the appropriate location and scored by match administrators when they retrieve them. The targets should be shot in order, 1-10. All 10 scores you report for the season will be used for your final score. There will be no use of any handicap system in this league. There will be two divisions, a bolt action and a semi-auto, you may shoot in both divisions if you wish. Awards will be given to the top shooters in each division.
