

Wi-Fi Calling via Club Internet Instructions Apple iPhone

The Lancaster Pistol and Rifle Club established Wi-Fi access for members physically at the club. Setting up Wi-Fi access is covered in the "Wi-Fi Setup Instructions" and must be completed before following the instructions below. Members may use this Wi-Fi access to place phone calls through your smart phone Wi-Fi calling feature. Below are instructions how to access Wi-Fi calling for Apple iPhone.

Limitations: Wi-Fi calling <u>does not</u> automatically communicate your address to emergency services in the same way a cellular service does. Should you need to call emergency services, you must communication the address of your emergency to the dispatcher.

Instructions for Apple iPhone

Make a call with Wi-Fi Calling

With Wi-Fi Calling, you can make or receive a phone call if you have a Wi-Fi connection in an area with little or no cellular coverage. Learn how to make a voice call using Wi-Fi Calling.

Place Wi-Fi calls from your iPhone

To turn on Wi-Fi calling, go to Settings > Phone > Wi-Fi Calling. You might need to enter or confirm your address for emergency services.

If Wi-Fi Calling is available, you'll see "Wi-Fi" in the status bar while viewing Control Center. Then your calls will use Wi-Fi Calling.

When cellular service is available, your iPhone uses it for emergency calls. If you turn on Wi-Fi Calling and cellular service isn't available, emergency calls might use Wi-Fi calling. Your device's location may be used to aid response efforts when you place an emergency call, regardless of whether you enable Location Services.

Instructions for Android

Make calls over Wi-Fi

In some cases, you can call people over a Wi-Fi connection instead of a mobile carrier. Not all carriers support calls over Wi-Fi.

Before you can make calls over Wi-Fi, you'll need to turn on the feature in your settings.

Important: Some of these steps only work on Android 6.0 and up. Learn how to check your Android version.

Turn on Wi-Fi calling

Important: You may incur additional charges for making calls over Wi-Fi, so check with your mobile service provider for details.

Use a mobile carrier's Wi-Fi calling

- 1. Open the Phone app 📞.
- 2. Tap More : > Settings.
- 3. Tap Calls.
- Tap Wi-Fi calling. If you don't see this option, it's because your carrier doesn't support this
 feature.
 - · You can use Wi-Fi calling without a service on some carriers.
 - If your carrier doesn't offer Wi-Fi calling, you can still do so through a voice over IP service.

Place a call using Wi-Fi

Once you've set up Wi-Fi calling, you can make a call over Wi-Fi just like any other call. When you're connected to the internet, you'll see "Internet Call" or "Wi-Fi calling" on the notification screen.

When you're not connected to Wi-Fi, your calls will use your mobile carrier, if you have one.
