Article XI section (K) "The use of steel targets shall only be conducted in the enclosed bunkers built for that purpose and on approved targets and in a manner approved by the Executive Committee. The 50-yard enclosed steel spinner bunker on the rifle range is for rimfire (non-magnum) only! The 100-yard enclosed steel plate bunker on the rifle range is for the use of personal steel plate targets provided by members using any allowed caliber per Section S below."

Reminder to all shooters that only rimfire (non-magnum, no .17 HMR or other necked cartridges) rounds to be used in the 50-yard bunker. Allowable centerfire cartridges may be used in the 100-yard bunker.
