



Bullseye Pistol League

Lancaster Pistol and Rifle club will be holding a weekly league shooting the National Match course of fire from May to October. Course of fire will be shot at 50 and 25 yards in accordance with CMP Pistol Rules. 12 firing positions are available with turning targets at 25 yards and static targets at 50 yards. League will take place from 7-9PM on Thursday nights with 2-3 courses of fire shot per night. Competitors recommended to show up at 7 for guaranteed squadding but may show up to shoot the second or 3rd course time permitting.

Date and Time: Thursday Nights 7-PM with the exception of any holidays, conflict with National Matches and Regional Tournaments, or extreme inclement weather. Every possible effort will be made to shoot the match.

Location: 3980 Brook Road, Lancaster, OH 43130

League Fees: League fees can be paid for either the entire 28 weeks or for 14 weeks at a time. Members fee for 14 weeks is \$20, and \$40 for the 28 weeks. Non-Members fees are \$40 for the 14 weeks, \$80 for the 28 or \$10/night.

Rules and Scoring: The current Edition of the CMP Pistol rules will be used that is available on-line at the CMP website. Competitors will be responsible for scoring (pass score card to the right, score to the left) and posting targets. If a competitor needs assistance it must be made known to the match director in order for accommodations to be made. Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI's) are mandatory.

Course of Fire: National Match Course of fire with any firearm that meets the requirements as outlined in Section 4 of the 26th Edition of the CMP Pistol Rulebook. Club league scores will be separated by .22 and Centerfire.

Equipment: ECIs, hearing and eye protection are mandatory. Stappers will be needed for posting and repairing targets. It is recommended the competitors have spotting scopes if desired.

- 10 shots Slow fire in 10 minutes at 50 yards on a B6 target
- Two 5 shot strings of Timed Fire, 20 seconds per string at 25 yards on a B8 target
- Two 5 shot strings of Rapid Fire, 10 seconds per string at 25 yards on a B8
