The **Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)** awards the **Distinguished Pistol Shot Badge** to competitors who earn **30 credit points** in Excellence in Competition (EIC) matches. Points are awarded based on a shooter's ranking among **non-distinguished** competitors, with awards ranging from **6 to 10 points** per match depending on placement.

To achieve distinction, a competitor must earn points across at least three different "legs" (matches), and **at least one** of those legs must be an **8 or 10-point** award.
